

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT SUPERVISORS

Inadequate supervision can result in worker injuries and deaths

SUPERVISORS:

1. Supervise the workplace at all times, either yourself or by having an assistant who is a competent person do so in your place
2. Inspect buildings, access and egress, facilities, structures, installations and equipment at least once a week
3. Ensure that workers work in compliance with the *Occupational Health and Safety Act* and its regulations

CONSTRUCTORS:

1. Appoint a competent supervisor for every project at which five workers will work at same time
2. Take every reasonable precaution in the circumstances to protect workers
3. Ensure all required posting, filing and signage requirements and emergency and rescue procedures are in place and are being complied with



WORKERS:

1. Report hazardous conditions and contraventions to your supervisor right away
2. Use and maintain your personal protective equipment as required by your employer
3. Know about your right to refuse unsafe work
